Adult Forum: Exploring the Resurrection with Matthew, Mark, and Luke

April 30th, May 7th, 14th, and 21st at 9:30 am

Join us for four Sundays in Easter as we explore the theologies of the Resurrection as articulated in the Synoptic Gospels. The class is based on *The Resurrection According to Matthew, Mark, and Luke* by Norman Perrin, New Testament scholar and author. In this brief book, Perrin suggests that these "resurrection narratives must be understood in both their similarities and their differences." With that in mind, he "relates each Synoptic account of the resurrection of Jesus to the theology of its Evangelist" resulting in "a new understanding of the importance of the Easter celebration." In addition to discussing these narratives from a scholarly perspective, Perrin reflects on what each Gospel's recounting of the resurrection means to him personally.
