From Interim Rector, Father Bill Blackerby

A Slight Change in Father Bill's Schedule and a Time to "Sit Quiet"

I've been an adjunct instructor in the University Honors Program at UAB since 1999. Most years I teach an honors seminar which meets for an hour and fifteen minutes two afternoons a week. This year, however, I'm one of six faculty members on the teaching team for the fall interdisciplinary course. I will offer a religious perspective on the course theme "Evidence and Belief in a Post-truth Society." This long standing commitment requires me to be at the Spencer Honors House Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday mornings from 9:05 a.m. to 12:05 p.m. I will continue to be in the office on Wednesdays but will arrive between 12:30 and 1:00 p.m. rather than in the morning. I will leave class early the second Wednesday of each month in time for the monthly Healing Eucharist.

Since I plan to be at Holy Spirit later in the day on Wednesdays during the fall, I going to head over to the nave each week for a half hour of holy silence at 5:30 p.m. Richard Rohr frequently calls this holy silence "sit quiet," a description I like a lot and the way I think of my morning time of silence. Many people experience this type of prayer as Centering Prayer. If your schedule permits, I'd love for you to join me Wednesday evenings beginning September 6th from 5:30 to 6:00 p.m. to sit quietly together in God's presence.
